

Farnsworth Memorial Scholarship

The Farnsworth Memorial Scholarship is funded by an endowment donated from the estate of the late Dr. Ray and Dena Farnsworth. They lived in Bozeman for many years and supported the school in a variety of ways. Their final gift established this fund to support students in pursuing their academic and spiritual goals.

The Farnsworth scholarship is intended to provide assistance for Montana students to attend Mt. Ellis Academy. The scholarship will be awarded and may be renewed based on academic performance, citizenship, and need. Applicants must meet the following minimum requirements to be considered for a scholarship:

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA (7th and 8th grade GPA for incoming freshmen)
- Have no major discipline infractions
- Maintain a B grade in attendance
- Fulfills required work obligation as outlined in financial plan
- Exhibit leadership qualities and a Christian example to other students

Scholarship recipients will be selected by the MEA Finance Committee from the group of applicants that meet the above criteria taking need into account. Scholarship awards will be given in the following amounts:

Village students - \$575 per semester

Dorm students - \$875 per semester

The scholarship may be renewed each semester the student remains in attendance and meets the minimum requirements above. Failure to meet the minimum requirements will result in a loss of the scholarship.
